



## PRIVACY INFORMATION NOTICE

### Related to Airbus Google Workspace Services

*Last updated – February 2023*

#### Introduction

Airbus SAS and its affiliates (also known as, “Airbus”, or “we” or “us”) have decided to deploy Google Workspace Services across the Airbus group. “Google Workspace” is a set of cloud computing tools, developed and provided by Google to Airbus companies, that are listed as Google Workspace Services in Appendix A “List of Google Workspace Services”.

Airbus is committed to protecting the privacy of individuals and to complying with applicable personal data protection laws and regulations.

Therefore, this Privacy Information Notice will inform you of the personal data required for or generated by using Google Workspace Services or otherwise processed through Google Workspace, how such personal data will be processed, how you can control and update the use and disclosure of your personal data, and how your personal data is protected through Airbus environment on Google Workspace.

This Privacy Information Notice applies to any user accessing Google Workspace Services through Airbus environment.

In addition, Google Workspace may include links to additional Google Workspace Services as defined in Appendix A which are not covered by this Privacy Information Notice. In this event, we encourage you to carefully read the privacy policies of such additional services or applications.

#### Which sources and what personal data do we use?

Personal data is information that can be used to identify a person either directly or indirectly. This definition covers a wide range of data enabling the identification of an individual.

The personal data we process under this Privacy Information Notice are as follows:

- **Identification data:** last name, first name, profile picture
- **Professional data:** email address, phone number, work address, department, job position
- **IT data / Digital activity data:** IP address, MAC address, access and activity logs, voice and audio information when you use audio features, people with whom you communicate or share content, activity on third-party sites and apps synced with your Google Account,
- **Account information:** role and permissions, settings and preferences, login, authentication;
- **All personal data as processed in Google Workspace Services** in accordance with Airbus Data Governance rules, tagged accordingly and under the responsibility of Google Workspace users. In addition, Private tagged Data shall be governed by the Airbus Information Systems & Technologies Charter.

For users provided with Airbus professional smartphones, additional personal data can be collected such as:

- **Location data:** GPS, IP address, sensor data from your device, information about things near your device, such as Wi-Fi access points, cell towers and Bluetooth-enabled devices)

We may collect this personal data:

- **directly** from you by fulfilling a form, by entering contact details, by navigating to Google Workspace Services, etc.
- **indirectly** for those personal data that are stored into other Airbus HR repository

## What are the purposes of the processing of your personal data?

By using Airbus Google Workspace Services, Airbus will collect and process your personal data for the following main purposes (hereinafter referred to as: the 'Purposes'):

- **E-mail messaging:**
  - Manage company messaging
  - Manage company calendars and meeting organisation
  - Ensure the routing of emails for inter-division exchanges
  - Ensure the view of availability and meetings of other Airbus IT users
  - Manage malfunctions
  - Ensure backups of electronic mailboxes and agendas
  - Manage the update of address books and of users' agenda
  - Enable task management for users
  - Enable contact management for users
  - Ensure Airbus, users and data protection
- **Chat and conference:**
  - Exchange text messages in real time
  - Make video and/or audio calls and/or conferences with other people declared in Airbus Active Directory
  - Share users' screen
  - See the state of presence of the people with whom users are connected
  - Collection of the uses for service improvement
  - Ensure Airbus, users and data protection
- **Collaborative office suite:**
  - Ensure that office documents can be created, viewed, edited, commented and shared in real time within people declared in Airbus Active Directory
  - Enable access to authorised users 24/7 from virtually anywhere
  - Exchange text messages and comments in real time
  - Enable version and revision control
  - See the state of presence of the people accessing the document
  - Ensure Airbus, users and data protection
- **Collaborative shared space**
  - Store and share files, to people declared in Airbus Active Directory
  - Provide internal websites space and tools
  - Manage users' rights to view, comment and/or edit files, documents and/or sites
  - Ensure effectiveness and control of access rights
  - Ensure Airbus, users and data protection

Personal data may be used for the additional following purposes:

1. the performance of the Google Workspace Services and related functionalities and their optimization and improvements,
2. for communicating with you in case of suspicious access, new functionalities, technical support, etc.
3. for incident resolution, error mistake and maintenance of the Google Workspace Services in general
4. for security purposes in relation to Google Workspace operations through notably monitoring and protection of connections, computers, network, systems and infrastructures
5. or detection, investigation or prevention of fraud and other illegal activities/issues
6. for billing and accounting
7. for compliance with law and regulation including responding to an authority or court order or discovery request

We will use your personal data for the above Purposes only, unless we reasonably consider that we need to use it for another reason and that reason is compatible with the original purpose (for preserving particular evidence under the applicable Data Protection Laws and Regulations, or in the context of legal statutes of limitation for example). If we need to use your personal data for an unrelated purpose, we will notify you prior to this further personal data processing and provide you the relevant information.

## What is the legal basis for the processing of your personal data?

We process your personal data under the following legal bases:

### ★ To follow contractual obligations.

The use of Google Workspace by Airbus employees and related use of the employee's personal data are necessary for the performance of the employee's employment contract as an IT means deployed across the group which is therefore the legal basis for such personal data collection and processing.

### ★ Within the scope of a legitimate interest.

On occasion taking into account the minimum privacy impact for you, the processing of your personal data might be necessary for the following legitimate interest:

- For fraud detection and prevention and investigation of criminal acts.
- For compliance with foreign law, law enforcement, court and regulatory bodies' requirements
- For information, system, network and cyber security within Airbus
- For general Corporate Operations and Due Diligence
- For product development and enhancement (incl. the analysis and optimization of the Website / Process / Application / Newsletter, etc.)
- For communications, marketing and intelligence
- For collaboration with extended enterprise or external partner

### ★ On the basis of Airbus' legal obligations

Airbus, as any other company, is subject to legal obligations and regulations. In some cases the processing of your personal data will be necessary for Airbus in order to fulfil these obligations.

## Who will receive your personal data?

We may disclose your personal data to the following recipient(s) on a strict need to know basis and for the Purposes as outlined in this Privacy Notice:

- Google LLC and its authorised subcontractor(s) acting as data processor;
- Airbus and its affiliates;
- Authorised persons working for or on behalf of Airbus, including our agents, service providers and advisers providing the variety of products and services we need such as IT maintenance and support, and compliance and/or security;
- Law enforcement or government authorities or other legal processes to obey applicable law, or in response to any subpoenas, court orders, or to establish or exercise our legal rights or to defend against legal claims.

## Is any of your personal data transferred overseas?

Your personal data will generally be processed in the European Economic Area and the UK. On occasion personal data is transferred to the relevant recipients as described in Section “*Who will receive your personal data?*”, on a need-to-know basis, including entities outside the EEA.

We may share your personal data within the Airbus group of companies. Any transfers within the Airbus group for Airbus daily business activity and internal organisation are covered by an intra-group agreement (see [Binding Corporate Rules](#)). The Binding Corporate Rules includes contractual protections to ensure that your personal data receives an adequate level of protection wherever it is transferred to within the group.

We may share some personal data to third parties located outside the European Economic Area and the UK.

The Google servers where your personal data is stored as part of the Airbus contractual terms with Google are as follows:

- Belgium
- Finland
- Ireland
- Netherlands
- USA

We always take steps to ensure that any transfer of information is carefully managed to protect your privacy rights:

- We will only transfer personal data to countries which are recognised as providing an adequate level of legal protection or where we are satisfied that arrangements are in place to protect your privacy rights,
- Transfers to service providers and other third parties will be protected by contractual commitments (such as the European Commission-approved Standard Contractual Clauses) or other legally acceptable mechanisms that ensure an adequate level of protection, and
- Any requests for personal data information we receive from law enforcement or regulators will be carefully checked before personal data is disclosed.

## How long will your personal data be stored?

We process and store your personal data from the date of collection and as long as it is required to meet Airbus contractual and local legal obligations, in accordance with the data protection laws requirements.

We retain the personal data that we collect for different periods of time depending on what it is, how we use it and how you configure your settings:

- Some personal data you can delete whenever you like, such as the content that you create or upload. You can also delete activity information saved in your account, or choose to have it deleted automatically after a set period of time.
- Other personal data is deleted or anonymised automatically after a set period of time. For example, to ensure that Google Workspace Services display properly on many different types of devices, we may retain browser width and height for up to nine (9) months.
- We keep some personal data until you delete your Google Account, such as information about how often you use our services.
- And some personal data we retain for longer periods of time when necessary for legitimate business or legal purposes, such as security, fraud and abuse prevention, or financial record-keeping.

When you delete personal data, we follow a deletion process to make sure that your personal data is safely and completely removed from our servers or retained only in anonymised form. We try to ensure that our services protect information from accidental or malicious deletion. Because of this, there may be delays between when you delete something and when copies are deleted from our active and backup systems.

## What about the security of your personal data?

We use technical and organisational security measures in order to protect the personal data we have under our control against accidental or intentional manipulation, loss, destruction and against access by unauthorised persons. Our security procedures are continually enhanced as new technology becomes available.

## What are your rights?

Under some circumstances provided by law, you may at any time exercise your data protection rights as listed below:

- **Right to access/obtain a report detailing the information held about you:** You have the right to obtain confirmation on whether or not your personal data is being processed by Airbus and if so, what specific personal data is being processed.
- **Right to correct personal data:** You have the right to rectify or request to have rectified any inaccurate personal data concerning you.
- **Right to be forgotten:** In some cases, for instance, when the personal data is no longer necessary in relation to the Purposes for which they were collected, you have the right for your personal data to be erased.
- **Right to restrict the processing of your personal data:** You have the right to restrict the processing of your personal data, for instance when the processing is unlawful and you oppose the erasure of your personal data. In such cases, your personal data will only be processed with your consent or for the exercise or defence of legal claims.
- **Right to data portability:** You have the right to receive the personal data concerning you in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and/or transmit those personal data to another data controller.
- **Right to object:** In some cases required by law, you may ask us to stop processing your personal data.

## How to exercise your rights and/or contact Airbus in respect of your personal data?

If you want to exercise your rights, if you are unhappy with the way in which your personal data has been processed, or you have questions regarding the processing of your personal data, please contact the Airbus personal data Protection Officer at the following email address: [dataprotection@airbus.com](mailto:dataprotection@airbus.com).

In case of doubt of your identity, we may ask you to justify it by enclosing a copy of any identity document.

## Are you obliged to provide your personal data?

Under certain circumstances, when some personal data is necessary to enter into a contract or to comply with legal obligation, any failure to provide the requested personal data may result in us not being able to fulfil our contractual/legal obligations or to achieve the expected results.

## Are your personal data the basis for automated decision-making, including profiling?

As a matter of principle, we do not use fully automated decision-making processes, including profiling. In the event that we should use such processes, we specifically inform you in advance of this and your rights in this respect as required by law.

## How to ask for assistance from the competent authorities?

If you remain unsatisfied, then you have the right to apply directly to a Data Protection Supervisory Authority. Listed below are the main countries where Airbus operates and the relevant Supervisory Authority

## Additional Notice

### for California residents

Pursuant to the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018 ("CCPA"): We do not sell your personal information to third parties and we will not sell your personal information to third parties unless provided otherwise by a specific privacy notice. Cross-border transfer of personal data related to Chinese residents will be subject to prior information and with your express consent. ## Cookies Policy

### WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small files or amounts of information that may be stored to, accessed and removed from your device when you access Google Workspace Services.

For instance, a "Cookie" may refer to "http cookie", "flash cookie" (used by some applications or website relying on Flash technology), local storage area of your internet browser, unique identifier calculated from your internet browser characteristics (also known as "browser fingerprinting"), or unique identifiers related to your device or your internet browser (device serial number, MAC address, Android ID, advertising ID, etc...)].

Cookies allow us to recognize your device and store information about your preferences or past actions. We may use Cookies:

1. (i) to record the preferences of our users,
2. (ii) to enable us to optimise the design of Google Workspace Services,
3. (iii) to ease navigation, and increase the user-friendliness of Google Workspace Services,
4. (iv) to analyse the usage of Google Workspace Services, and/or to identify the most popular sections of Google Workspace Services,
5. (v) to provide content that is more accurately suited to your needs, and, in doing so, improve Google Workspace Services. Cookies can be used to determine whether there has been any contact between us and your device in the past,
6. (vi) to facilitate secure online access so that you do not need to enter your user ID and password again when you access Google Workspace Services.

### WHICH COOKIES DO WE USE?

Cookies contain personal data. The table below aims to inform you about the type and purpose of each cookies, and the type of personal data processed inside, and that we may use on Google Workspace Services:

Without these cookies, the website cannot function properly.</p> <p>For example, we use a cookie called 'lbc' which makes it possible for Google Docs to open many Docs in one browser. Blocking this cookie would prevent Google Docs from operating correctly.</p>	Mandatory
Session State	<p>Websites often collect information about how users interact with a website. This may include the pages users visit most often and whether users get error messages from certain pages. We use these so-called 'session state cookies' to help us improve our services, in order to improve our users' browsing experience. Blocking or deleting these cookies will not render the website unusable.</p> <p>These cookies may also be used to anonymously measure the effectiveness of PPC (pay per click) and affiliate advertising.</p> <p>For example, we use a cookie called 'recently_watched_video_id_list' so that YouTube can record the videos most recently watched by a particular browser.</p>	Optional

#### HOW CAN YOU DISABLE OR DELETE COOKIES?

When the Cookies we use are strictly necessary for technical reasons, they are marked as "mandatory" on the table above. Those Cookies do not require consent from you. However, if you choose not to accept Cookies that are strictly necessary for the provision of our services provided by our Website, it may result in a reduced availability of such services.

For the Cookies that require a consent from you, please be informed that you can revoke this consent at any time.



You can also manage and control the cookies we use, and delete them directly on Google Chrome through the cookies settings interface, with the following URL: chrome: chrome://settings/content/cookies.

You can prevent Cookies from being stored on your device by setting your browser to refuse cookies. The exact instructions for this can be found in the manual for your browser. You can also delete Cookies already on your device at any time through your browser's settings.

For the purpose of statistical analysis, we use analytics tools relying on specific Cookies. You may object at any time to the collection and analysis of statistical data regarding your access to and use of Google Workspace Services through the cookies settings interface mentioned above.
